BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF WELLSTON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

The City of Wellston Auditor is hereby authorized to establish and thereby Section One: it is hereby established the following Fund: 237 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN Fund

Section Two: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Wellston, in that it is necessary to approve this additional appropriation in order that expenses can be timely paid as incurred and in accordance with the city's obligations. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in the Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to Section Three: receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
