CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS PROCESS

Any exterior alterations, new construction, or demolition in the Wellston Historic District must first be approved by the Wellston Historic Review Board (WHRB) or its staff. The WHRB is made up of five residents of Wellston who have a strong interest in historic preservation. The proposed plans will receive a detailed review to ensure the changes follow the Wellston Historic District Review Guidelines prior to issuance of a Certificate of Appropriateness (COA). There is no charge to obtain a COA.

The following information is required, along with a completed application, before a review can be conducted:

NEW CONSTRUCTION

Scaled Drawings Site Plan Photographs Material List

SIGNS

Scaled Drawings Location of Sign on Property Photographs Width of Building Lot Frontage

ADDITIONS/ALTERATIONS

Photographs Scaled Drawings Material List

DEMOLITION

See Review Board for List of Required Documents

The COA application will be reviewed by the WHRB or its staff. If the application follows the Wellston Historic Review Guidelines, then staff can approve the application. Most applications are approved within a few working days.

The completed application must be submitted no later than 14 days prior to the scheduled alteration. If the application is not in compliance with the Wellston Historic District Review Guidelines, the WHRB will collaborate with the applicant to meet/understand the requirements.

It may also be necessary to apply for a building or zoning permit. Applications are available at the Wellston City Building.
