ORDINANCE NO. 2023-41

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO THE INDIGENT DEFENSE CONTRACT WITH THE JACKSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SO AS TO PROVIDE LEGAL COUNSEL TO INDIGENT PERSONS CHARGED WITH VIOLATIONS OF THE WELLSTON MUNICIPAL CODE FOR 2023**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wellston., Ohio is obligated to provide legal counsel to indigent persons charged with violating the Wellston Municipal Code, greater than a minor misdemeanor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Jackson County Commissioners have contracted with the Ohio Public Defenders Commission to provide counsel to indigent persons and have made arrangements for this legal counsel to provide defense to indigent persons charged with violating the Wellston City Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract for the calendar year 2023 beginning on January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 is attached hereto and is incorporated herein and the agreement calls for payment in the amount of \$19,958.66 upon its approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the rate for legal services provided pursuant to the agreement is reasonable and less than those otherwise available and it is necessary for the preservation of the health and welfare of the City of Wellston that this agreement be approved immediately and, due to the amount of time by which payment must be made, this matter constitutes an emergency.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Council for the City of Wellston, Ohio hereby ordains that the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into the agreement for indigent defense services in Municipal Court as attached hereto.

**SECTION 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and the deliberations of this council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
