ORDINANCE NO. 2023-51

AN ORDINANCE FOR TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE 212 FIRE LEVY FUND TO PURCHASE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The transfer is as follows:



Section 2. This is an emergency necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare so funds are available for the earliest possible purchase of personal protective equipment necessary for the protection of the fire fighters of the City of Wellston Fire Department. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.



PASSED AND ADOPTED by the legislative authority of the City of Wellston this 3rd day of August, 2023.




