## ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05

### AN ORDINANCE REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY CHAPTER 114 OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX OR BED TAX.

**Section 1.** WHEREAS the City has enacted Ordinance 3383 and caused it to be included in the Codified Ordinances of the City of Wellston as Chapter 114, Transient Occupancy Tax, and includes sections 114.01 through 114.99, also commonly referred to as the bed tax; and

**Section 2.** WHEREAS the legislative authority of the City of Wellston has determined that Chapter 114 of its Codified Ordinances is not now required; and

**Section 3.** THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT CHAPTER 114, TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX, IS HEREBY **REPEALED** IN ITS ENTIRETY AND THAT IT BE REMOVED FROM THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


