**ORDINANCE 2024-17**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF RECREATION DIRECTOR AND ESTABLISHING SALARY.**

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Wellston, Ohio:

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is responsible for the creation of new positions within the City and setting the compensation of such positions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has recommended the creation of the position of Recreation Director who shall be the administrative head of the recreation department of the City and who shall serve as an assistant with a fiduciary relationship to the Director of Public Service and Safety in the management of City recreation programs, ball fields and the development and management of future recreation facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the position of Recreation Director shall be an unclassified service position within the City pursuant to O.R.C. section 124.11; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO:**

**Section 1:** The position of Recreation Director shall be in the unclassified service of the City and serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and perform the duties described herein and as established by the Director of Public Service and Safety.

**Section 2:** The annual salary shall be \$55,000 to \$60,000 and shall be paid on a biweekly basis.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
