ORDINANCE NO. 2024-48

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN GENERAL CIVIL- SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, AND MAINTENANCE FOR THE PURCHASE OF BULLETPROOF VESTS THROUGH THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BULLETPROOF VEST PROGRAM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The prior appropriations regarding the General Civil Fund (Supplies, Materials, and Maintenance) is hereby modified to appropriate additional money as follows:

Section 2. This Ordinance is necessary for the transfer of funds to be made available to pay expenses associated with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation's Ohio Law Enforcement Bulletproof Vest Program as they become due.

Section 3. The Auditor is authorized to account for the activity authorized herein as is appropriate under the circumstances of this ordinance and in accordance with City policies and procedures, or as otherwise required by law. The City attorney is authorized to correct as he determines appropriate any clear scrivener or clerical error in this ordinance, and to provide a clean copy for the council clerk.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
