**ORDINANCE 2024-61**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF CUSTODIAN CARETAKER AND ESTABLISHING PAY**

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Wellston, Ohio:

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is responsible for the creation of new positions within the City and setting the compensation of such positions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has recommended the creation of the part-time position of Custodian Caretaker who shall be responsible for the cleaning, maintenance, and upkeep of all janitorial cleaning, minor construction needs, snow removal, and minor HVAC/Electrical repairs for the City of Wellston; and

**WHEREAS**, the position of Custodian Caretaker shall be a part-time non-bargaining unit position to be paid at rate of \$15.00 per hour.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO:**

**Section 1:** The position of Custodian Caretaker is hereby created as a part-time position to be filled by the Mayor to perform the job duties as established by the Director of Public Service and Safety.

**Section 2:** The Custodian Caretaker shall be paid \$15.00 hourly and shall be scheduled hours as a part-time employee as determined necessary by the Director of Public Service and Safety.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
