## RESOLUTION NO. 2025-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF FORGE FIRE AND COMPANY, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$140,300.00, FOR A FIRE BURN CHAMBER AND FIRE PROTECTION AREA FOR THE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for the installation of a fire burn chamber and fire protection area for use for training by the City Fire Department, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid was from Forge Fire and Company, in the amount of \$140,300.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The legislative authority of the City of Wellston hereby authorizes the Service-Safety Director or his designee to accept the bid submitted by Forge Fire and Company, in the amount of \$140,300.00.

<u>Section 2.</u> In order that the project may be completed timely and for the bid amount and at the earliest possible date, as the completion of the fire training facility is an important program necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare of the City. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section 3.</u> In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
