A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF INVENTORY AND EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE CITY FOR RECREATION PROJECTS FROM MAKE WELLSTON BEAUTIFUL, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Make Wellston Beautiful, Inc., a non-profit corporation, has offered to the City of Wellston inventory, equipment, and miscellaneous items identified in pages attached hereto, to the City of Wellston; and

WHEREAS, the offered inventory, equipment and miscellaneous items will be beneficial to the City and will serve a municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston agrees to accept the donation of the property described in the attached pages and declares that this matter constitutes an emergency as the ownership of the property and the ability to take immediate possession of it and to insure it are necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO, HEREBY ACCEPTS OWNERSHIP OF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED HEREIN AND DIRECTS THAT IT BE LISTED AS PROPERTY OF THE CITY FOR INSURANCE PURPOSES AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 123.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
