AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE UNCLAIMED REFUNDS FUND FROM THE UNCLAIMED FUND CARRYOVER FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance Section 2. necessary for the return of unclaimed funds to the Ohio Department of Commerce for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Wellston; therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to Section 3. receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council Section 4. relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
