ORDINANCE NO. 2026-18

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL IN ITS ENTIRETY ORDINANCE NO. 2021-63, THAT ESTABLISHED THE POSITION OF PUBLIC WORKS SUPERVISOR AND ITS SALARY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wellston, Ohio, previously adopted Ordinance No. 2021-63, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing the Position of Public Works Supervisor and Setting the Salary and Benefits for the Public Works Supervisor of the City of Wellston, Ohio"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now determines that Ordinance No. 2021-63 should be repealed in its entirety as the position is no longer necessary and the duties have been separately assigned through other positions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that repealing said ordinance is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO:

SECTION ONE. That Ordinance No. 2021-63, passed and adopted by the legislative authority of the City of Wellston in December 2021, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION TWO. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, that are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
