Resolution No. 2026-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND (WPCLF) AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WASTEWATER FACILITIES AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston seek to upgrade its existing wastewater facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston intends to apply for Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) for the planning, design and or construction of the wastewater facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source; now therefore,

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City to adopt the proposed Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Wellston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply for a WPCLF loan, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for construction of wastewater facilities on behalf of the City of Wellston Ohio.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said City of Wellston for the reason that the immediate construction of Wastewater Facilities at the earliest possible time is necessary in order to protect the health of the inhabitants of the LGA by providing safe and reliable public drinking water; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.

SECTION 4: In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
