RESOLUTION 2026-44

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WELLSTON AND JACKSON TOWNSHIP TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston, through its fire department wishes to provide fire protection services to the Township of Jackson; and,

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated the terms of such an agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Wellston, County of Jackson, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract between the City of Wellston and Jackson Township, to provide Jackson Township with fire protection services, a copy of that agreement has been provided to Council attached as Exhibit A, and is for a period not to expire, beginning January 1st, 2027 and said Exhibit A is hereby approved and adopted by this body.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Fire Protection Contract Between the City of Wellston and Jackson Town Township Jackson County Ohio

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT THAT this is a contract for the provision of fire protection and safety services, made between the City of Wellston, Ohio and the Township of Jackson, Jackson County, Ohio WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by resolution of Council of the City of Wellston, Ohio, the Director of Public Service and Public Safety of the City of Wellston, Ohio and the Chief of the Wellston Fire Department, on behalf of said City, have been authorized to enter into the contract for the purpose of furnishing fire protection and safety protection to the inhabitants of Jackson Township for a period not to expire on the terms and conditions set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees of Jackson Township, Jackson County, Ohio on the 1st day of January 2027, said Trustees authorized the execution of a contract on behalf of said township with the City of Wellston, Ohio, for such service.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Wellston, Ohio, hereby agrees that its Division of Fire, Department of Public Safety, will provide full time staffing and answer calls from said Jackson Township Fire District and inhabitants and send firefighters thereto for the purpose of extinguishing fires, vehicle extrication, providing medical first response, water rescue, and other necessary safety services to protect the inhabitants of Jackson Township Fire District for a period not to expire, beginning January 1st, 2027 and for each year after an increase of 3% will be figured and automatically be billed by the City of Wellston. The City of Wellston Division of Fire will provide monthly fire reports to the Jackson Township Clerk.

In consideration for which the said Jackson township, Jackson County, Ohio, agrees to pay the City of Wellston – Division of Fire, the sum of \$25,000.00 per year, to be paid in two installments of \$12,500.00 each, the first being due on March 1st and the second being due on July 1st. In consideration for which the said Jackson Township, Jackson County, Ohio, agrees to pay the City of Wellston – Division of Fire, for said services, in accordance with the following schedule:

- \$12,500.00, Due, and payable before March 1st, 2027
- \$12,500.00, Due, and payable before July 1st, 2027

It is mutually understood and agree that in no instance shall the City of Wellston, Ohio be liable in damages to said Jackson Township, or any of its inhabitants for failure to answer any fire or emergency call or lack of speed in answering such calls or for any inadequacy of equipment, negligent operation of apparatus, failure to extinguish fire, or any other cause whatsoever growing out of this agreement or use of the fire equipment and the personnel of said

City of Wellston, Ohio; and that said fire equipment shall not be expected to answer calls where roads are impassible.

It is also understood that there is a right to re-negotiation of this contract should the City of Wellston annex any portion of Jackson Township or the City of Wellston reduces fire services provided. It is further understood that there is a right to re-negotiation of this contract should there be a significant change in the population of Jackson Township, significant change in the number of businesses residing in Jackson Township or a levy be placed on the ballot for fire protection in Jackson Township.

Term and Termination. This Agreement shall commence on January 1, 2027, and shall continue indefinitely unless terminated by either party. Either party may terminate this Agreement, with or without cause, by providing not less than one (1) year prior written notice to the other party. During the notice period, all terms and obligations of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
